### Project description:

The "Partnerships 4 Women Leadership and Good Governance" project is financed by the European Union and Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung and implemented by Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung Moldova and Institutum Virtutes Civilis. The general objective of the project is to enhance the capacity of Moldovan civil society organisations and women to participate in decision-making processes and bring positive changes in their communities.

## **Expected results:**

- 100 women selected for participation in the Leadership Academy "Women for Good Governance" and trained. The participants will learn about the role of women in the decision-making process; the role of political parties in the development of democracy; electoral legislation, rules for registration and participation in the electoral race; elements of a public speech and a personal development plan and the mission statement.
- 30 representatives of Moldovan civil society organisations, local initiative groups and local action groups strengthened their knowledge and skills in good governance (decision-making transparency, participatory public policy making, anti-corruption, LPA integrity and public procurement monitoring).
- 2 Memorandum of Understanding signed 1 with the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection and 1 with the Academy of Public Administration.
- A baseline study on the perception and attitude of the population of the 4 target rayons (Ialoveni, Straseni, Rezina and Telenesti) regarding the importance and role of women in decision-making processes.

  The study will as well analyse the sustainable development.
- 4 cooperation agreements signed with the partner rayons Ialoveni, Straseni, Rezina and Telenesti.
- 80 participants project partners and beneficiaries, including representatives of the European Union Delegation to the Republic of Moldova, central and local public authorities, local and national civil society organisations, international
