The project is aimed at assisting the Government of Ukraine with the implementation of the 2016-2020 Public Administration reform Strategy and its Implementation Plan, as well as other connected policy documents and their implementation plans in a comprehensive and consistent manner in line with the principles of public administration developed by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) and the Support for Improvement in Governance and Management (SIGMA).

Expected results:

Component 1 – Strategic framework of Public Administration Reform Results:

- 1.1 Coordination, monitoring and reporting structures of the PAR Strategy implementation are operational at both political and administrative levels, including through regular policy dialogue involving key stakeholders and development partners.
- 1.2 Capacity of institutions in charge of implementation of the PAR Strategy is further improved based on regular needs assessments and targeted capacity development measures (linked to results under component 3 and 4).
- 1.3 The PAR Strategy is consistently and regularly monitored, assessed and, where necessary reviewed in line with the OECD/SIGMA Principles of Public Administration.
- 1.4 Government-led donor coordination in the area of PAR established and operational at both strategic and operational levels.
- 1.5 Annual planning documents on the (human and financial) resources required to implement the PAR Strategy are linked to the general budget process and their execution is consistently monitored and assessed (linked to results under component 2).
