









Findings based on citizens who frequently look for information on the EU


Where or from whom did you hear information about the EU?

Accessibility of information on the EU

9 out of 10 citizens often find the information they are looking for.

Most find it accessible, user-friendly and comprehensive



7 out of 10 citizens look up EU-related news in their native language, 2 out of 10 in Russian, and only 1 out of 10 in English
