






ENERGY CONSUMPTION

Azerbaijan used a total of 14.3 million tonnes of oil equivalent (Mtoe) in 2015.

DID YOU KNOW?

This corresponds to 1.49 toe of energy consumption per capita per year. With 1.49 toe of fuel, a Boeing 737-800 can fly from Baku to Teheran.


Energy production

Azerbaijan is a major crude oil producer (26th world ranking in 2016) and a significant producer of natural gas. Because of this large hydrocarbon production, it has one of the highest energy self-sufficiency ratios in the world: the country energy production is more than four times its energy demand.



Exports

Azerbaijan was the 17th largest crude oil exporter in 2016 of 35 million tonnes including natural gas liquids.



TRANSFORMATION


Electricity Generation

Azerbaijan produced 25 TWh of electricity in 2015, mostly from natural gas (86%).

Renewables accounted for 7% of the electricity mix.




Azerbaijan also has a refinery producing diesel, motorgasoline, and other products (6.5Mtoe in total in 2015) for local and export markets.
