



Invest to reduce your energy use at home

Energy efficiency is a priority area for the EU, which funds a range of initiatives to reduce energy use in the Eastern Partnership region.

Investing to make your building energy efficient will bring the biggest long-term returns in terms of smaller bills, greater comfort and increased property value. Significant investment requires specialised expertise, so ask an expert to carry out an **energy audit** of your home to identify weak points in the building and help **plan improvements** in the most cost-effective way.



Some measures to make a big difference



Fully insulate the building to high energy-efficiency standards and reduce heat loss by **20-30%**.



Install **heating with an automated weather regulating system** that takes into account outside weather, reducing energy consumption by **15-40%**.



Insulate and **waterproof the basement**, reducing energy losses by **10-12%**.



Insulate external walls and roofs and cut energy use by **20-30%**.



Install a **solar thermal collector** on the roof to cover hot water needs.



Install **heat pumps** to increase energy efficiency by **over 50%**.
