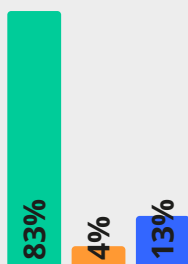

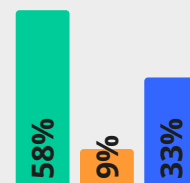

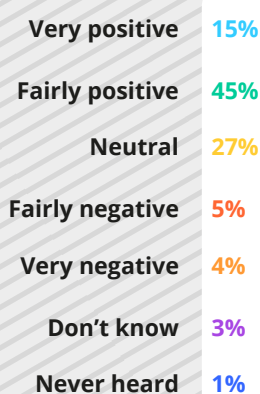

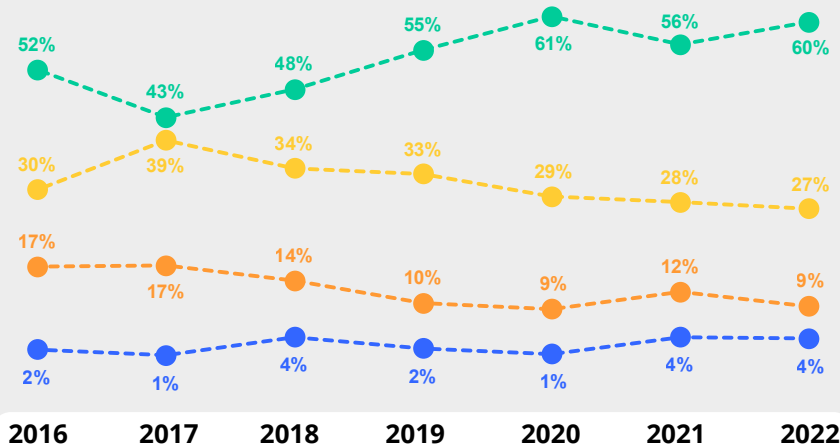

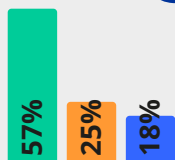

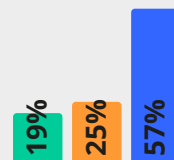

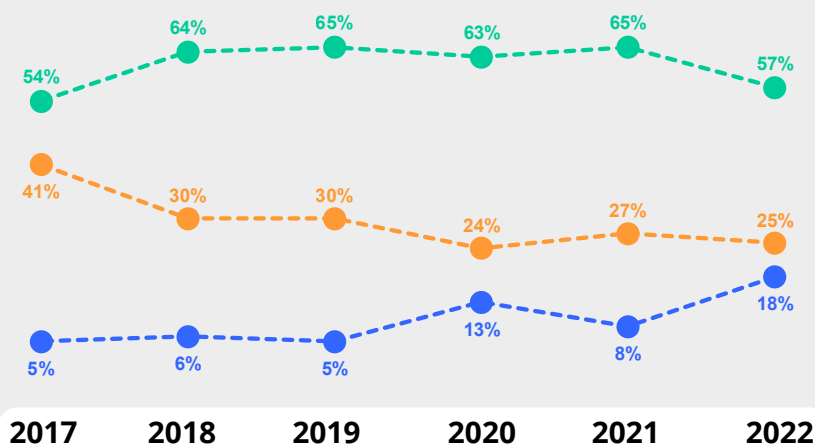

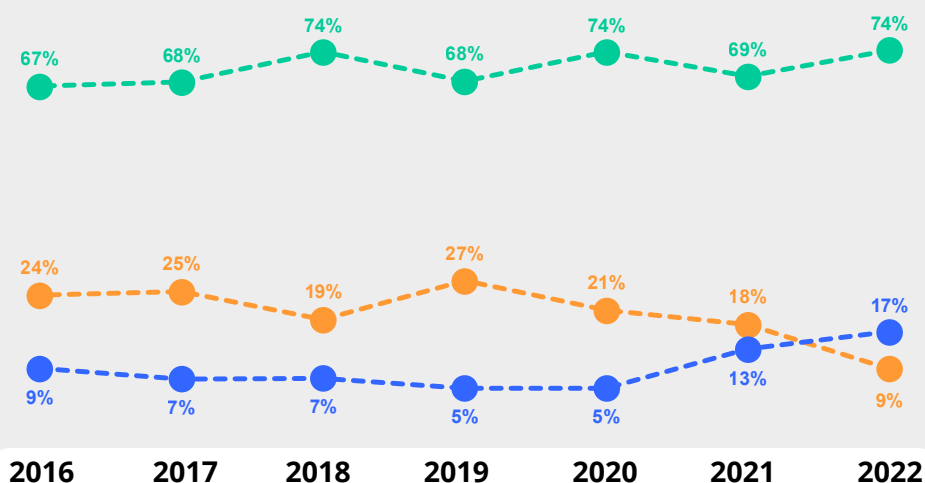

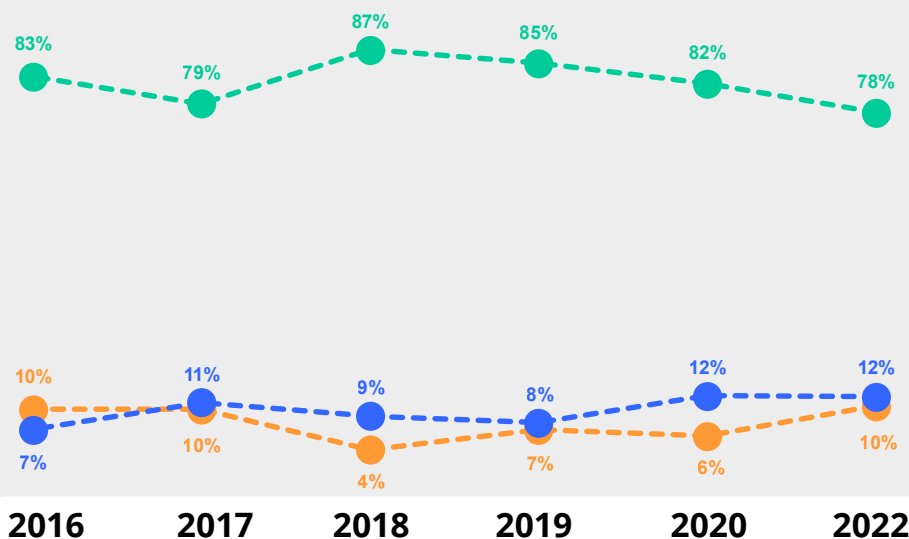

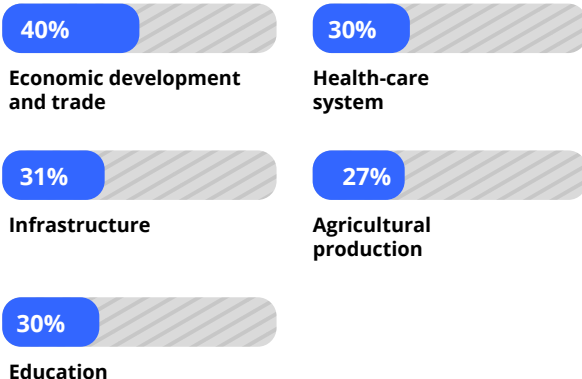

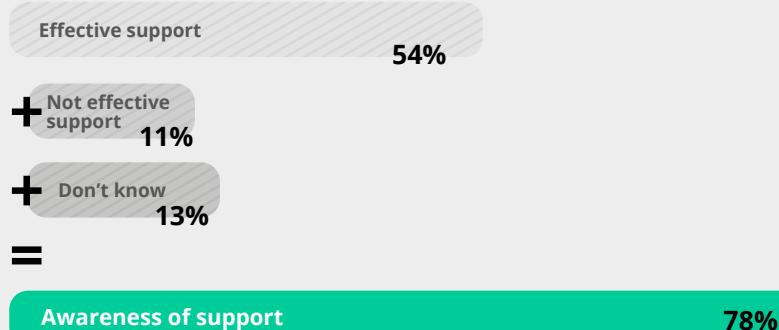

Five most important areas where the EU should play a greater role in supporting Moldova

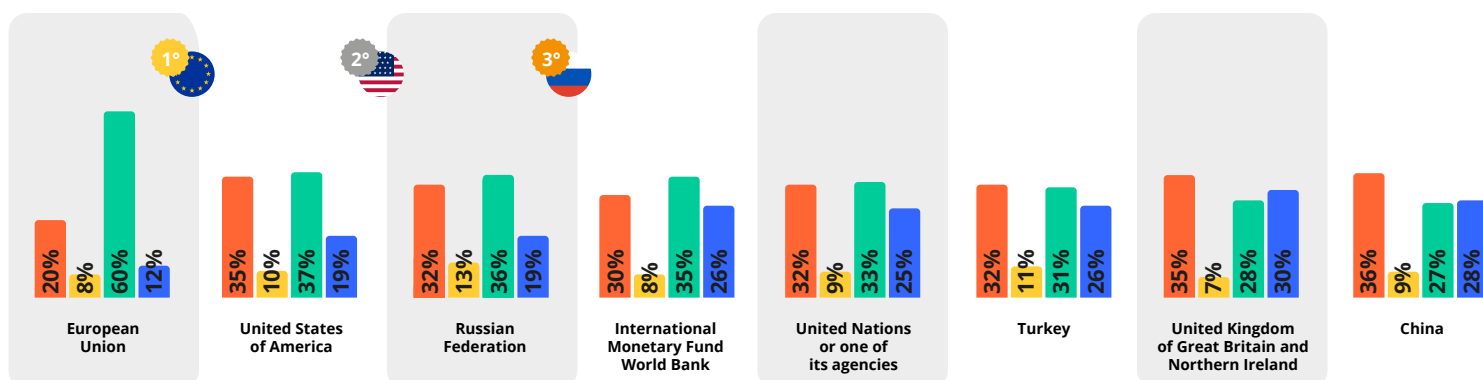


Effectiveness of the EU's financial support
