WHAT IS THE EU4 GENDER EQUALITY REFORM HELPDESK?

The EU4 Gender Equality Reform Helpdesk provides demand-driven assistance to governments and EU Delegations in Eastern Partnership countries on mainstreaming gender in policy-making and the implementation of reforms to ensure the delivery of effective results for women and men.

1. TECHNICAL EXPERTISE AND ADVISORY ASSISTANCE



Gender mainstreaming in government documents and draft laws:

- Support for the Parliament of Georgia on the Gender Impact Assessment of the Draft Law of Georgia on Food Loss and Waste Reduction, Food Recovery and Redistribution

 - Ministry of Justice and the Training Center of Justice of Georgia, 18–19 July 2022 (12 participants; 9 women and 3 men)
 - Ministry of Internally Displaced Persons from the Occupied Territories, Labour, Health and Social Affairs of Georgia, 20 July 2022 (14 participants; 11 women and 3 men)
 - Prosecutor's Office of Georgia, 22 July 2022 (10 participants; all women)
 - Ministry of Environmental Protection and Agriculture of Georgia, 1–2 December 2022 (16 participants; 10 women and 6 men)

Trainings for EU Delegation staff:

- Training on gender equality and gender mainstreaming for staff of the EU Delegation to Georgia, 30–31 May 2022 (22 participants; 6 men and 16 women)

Assistance for organising public participation and consultation working groups:

- Support for the EU Delegation to Georgia to organise a meeting with the Government and Parliament of Georgia to present the Country Level Implementation Plan (CLIP)
- Support for the Parliament of Georgia with the public presentation of the Gender Impact Assessment of the Draft Law of Georgia on Food Loss and Waste Reduction, Food Recovery and Redistribution

2. CAPACITY BUILDING ACTIVITIES



Trainings/workshops/seminars that increased the gender mainstreaming capacities and skills of public servants, both women and men:

- Business, Human Rights, and Gender Equality offline training for the Business Ombudsman's Office of Georgia, 20 May 2022 (10 participants; 6 women and 4 men)

Study visit:

- Organisation of a visit of representatives of the Government of Armenia to Georgia (27–30 June 2022) to share experiences of combatting sexual and gender-based violence, and domestic violence. The visit involved meetings with governmental institutions in Georgia, including the Inter-agency Commission on Gender Equality, Violence Against Women and Domestic Violence; the Gender Equality Council of the Parliament of Georgia; the Public Defender's Office of Georgia; the National Statistics Office of Georgia (GEOSTAT); the Ministry of Internal Affairs; the Ministry of Internally Displaced Persons, Labour, Health and Social Affairs of Georgia; and the Agency for State Care and Assistance for Victims of Human Trafficking. Participants forged closer ties, shared experiences, and the Public Defender's Offices of Georgia and Armenia now plan to conduct joint research.

- Study visit of government delegations from Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine to EU institutions in Brussels, 5–9 December 2022, to increase their knowledge of EU gender equality acquis and raise awareness of the EU Gender Equality Strategy 2020–2025 (10 Georgian government officials participated; 8 women and 2 men)
