2. CAPACITY BUILDING ACTIVITIES

- 10 training sessions for gender focal points in executive bodies on conducting gender analysis of emergency and recovery policies and programmes, February-October 2022 (68 civil servant participants – 59 women and 9 men)
- 2 workshops for public institutions on gender audits (117 participants from ministries and public institutions 98 women and 19 men)
- Webinar on "gender equality and women's rights in the health care sector" for staff of the National Health Service of Ukraine (NHSU), 13 March 2023 (51 participants – 42 women and 9 men)
- 2 trainings for the development of civil servants' gender competences, 14–15 March 2023 (42 participants – 33 women and 9 men)
- 4 webinars on "gender equality in security sector", May– June 2023 (21 participants – 13 women and 8 men)
- 8 webinars on "gender equality in security sector" for the State Service of Ukraine for Emergency Situations, July– August 2023 (57 participants – 31 women and 26 men)
- 2 online trainings on "gender-sensitive response to humanitarian crisis" for civil servants, 1–4 August 2023 (100 participants – 71 women and 29 men)
- 2 online trainings on "gender mainstreaming in local policies, planning and budgeting", 7–10 August 2023 (83 participants – 78 women and 5 men)
- 2 online trainings on "gender-oriented needs assessment and gender-sensitive communication" for civil servants, 25–26 September 2023 (58 participants – 46 women and 12 men)
