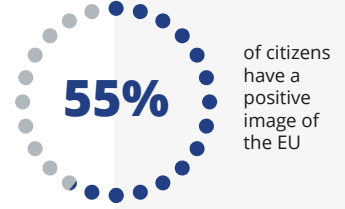
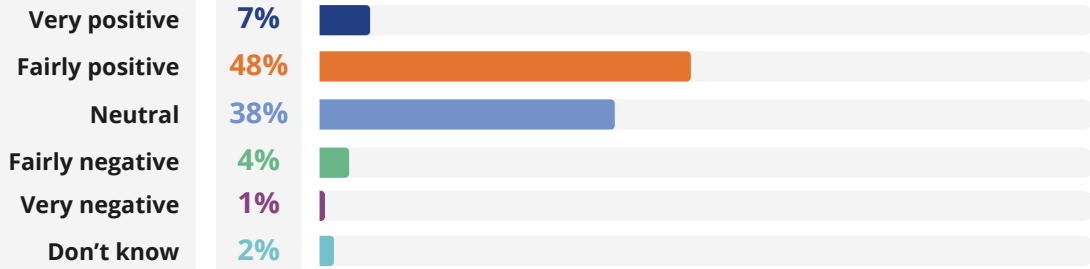

Top three factors citizens say would make them more positively disposed towards the EU

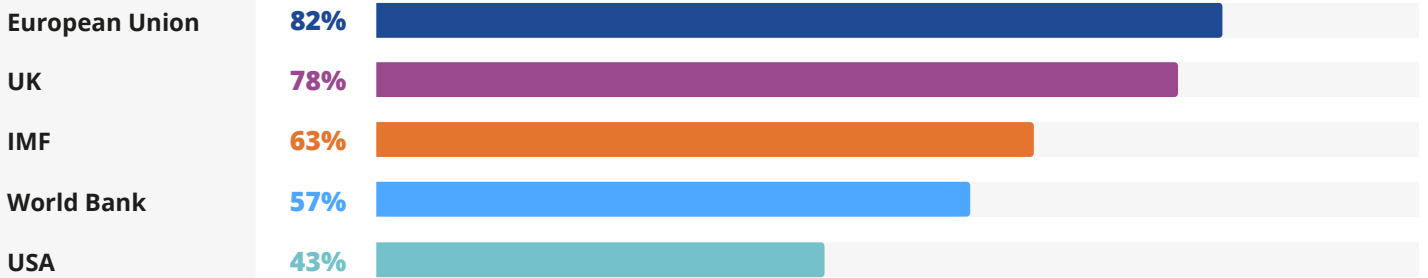


Top three areas where citizens say the EU should play a greater role in supporting Ukraine



Trust towards the EU, countries and international institutions

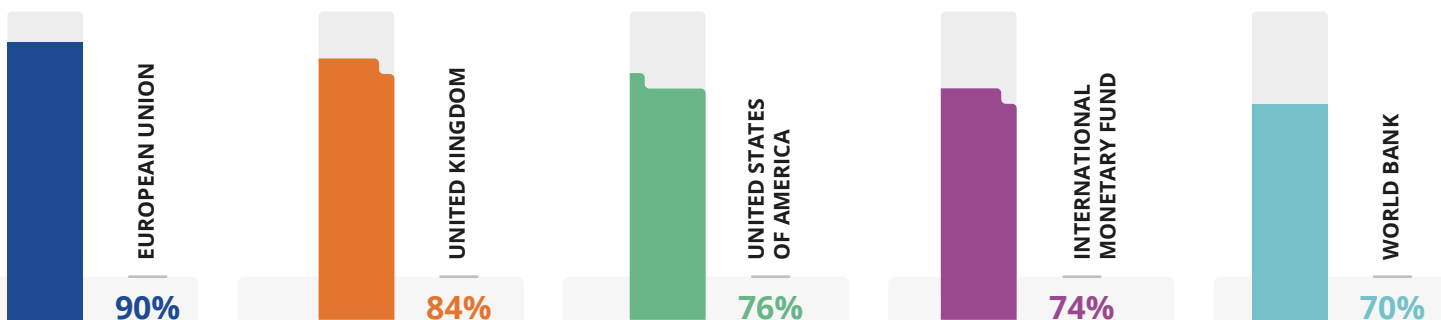

EU financial support to Ukraine

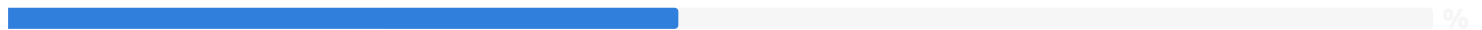
96% of citizens are aware of the EU's financial support



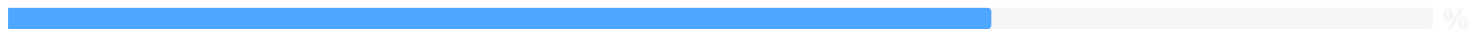
64% of citizens rate the EU's support as high or very high



47% of citizens believe that the EU is the country's largest financial contributor

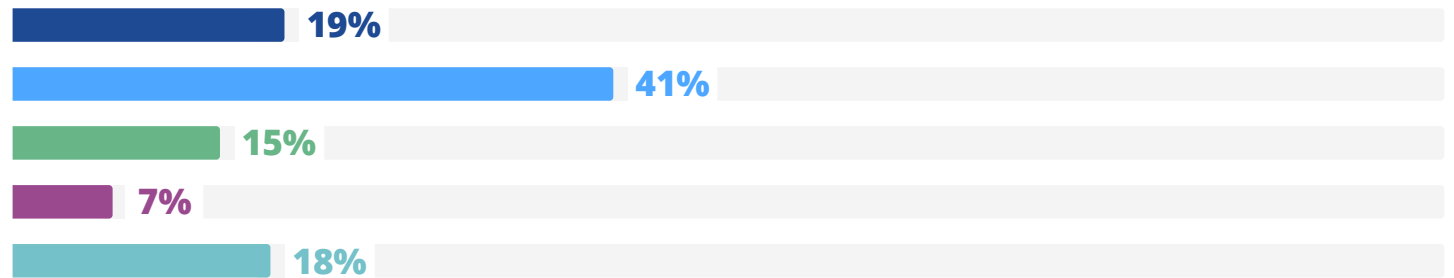


69% of citizens rate the EU's support as effective

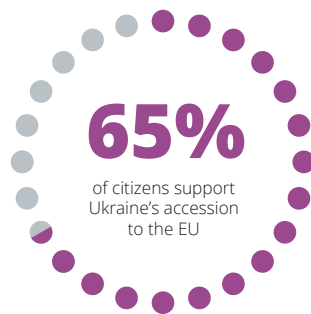
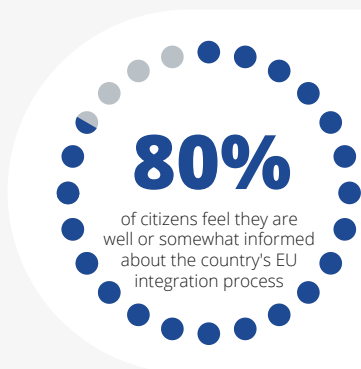

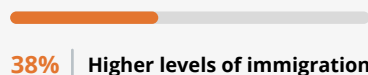
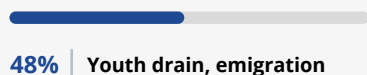
Citizens' views on EU accession
